ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Overall

- Able to layout and build temporary barricades.
- Receive fixtures and record properly.
- Proficient in all hand/power tools.
- Able to lead and give clear direction to Harco laborers and temp labor.
- Able to communicate clearly and professionally with other Harco employees, clients and customers.
- Able to help, teach or coach others in learning a new skill and work as a team.
- Keep track of company provided tools and equipment.
- Check deliveries for accuracy and completeness by reviewing shipping copy.
- Turn in all receipts for items or materials purchased on company accounts or credit cards to supervisor.
- Maintain and turn in time sheet with appropriate approval on a weekly basis.
- Special projects as required.

Rough Carpentry

- Able to layout and build wood trench covers and temporary barricades.
- Able to assist in rough carpentry and framing.
- Have knowledge of construction lumber types and sizes.
- Have knowledge and ability to perform most rough carpentry applications.
- Able to layout and build roof top platforms and curbs for equipment pads.
- Able to install impact doors.
- Knowledge of doors and hardware.
- Able to install metal doors and jambs, solid core doors and needed hardware.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS
