## Concrete / Form Work & Set Up

- Has adequate knowledge to assist in form setting
- Has knowledge and is able to set up forms with little or no supervision
- Able to read plans and perform material take offs for items needed to set forms
- Able to shoot grades for elevations
- Can accurately assist in the placing and tying of rebar
- Can place and secure rebar with little or no supervision

## **Concrete / Finishing**

- Can skillfully use all hand trowels and floats
- Able to use a power trowel/machine and concrete vibrator
- Able to perform minor VCT repairs and set base
- Able to place and finish rapid set concrete with little or no supervision
- Able to apply concrete sealers and cures correctly if needed
- Able to perform patch and repair applications with other cement products
- Demonstrates leadership skills needed to run a concrete pour
- Takes initiative and responsibility during a pour

#### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS**
